



**Beata Caranci** is the Chief Economist and Senior Vice President for TD Bank Group. Beata joined TD in 2003 and now oversees three economic teams. One is tasked with delivering forecasts and research for TD clients, the second oversees economic risk and regulatory requirements, and the third is uniquely positioned as a thought leader in environmental and social policy research. Beata is also on several influential committees, including the American Bankers' Economic Advisory Committee that regularly meets with the Federal Reserve, as well as Canada's C.D. Howe's Monetary Policy Council.

Beata's commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion is captured by two decades of research on identifying and proposing solutions to break down the barriers women face in the labour market. Her report, "Get on Board Corporate Canada," helped influence the Ontario Securities Commission's rule amendments on disclosure of women on boards. In 2024, Beata was appointed the Chair of TD's Disability Inclusion Network.

Beata's distinguished evidenced-based research combined with the breadth of her role as Chief Economist for TD Bank earned the Professional category award by WXN's Canada's Most Powerful Women in 2019. Under Beata's leadership, TD Economics won the Best Forecaster Award 2024 for Canada from FocusEconomics.
