


Canada-U.S. Trade Relationship

Canada is the #1 export market for U.S. goods and services.




Canada has the 2nd smallest deficit.

Deficit (\$US Billions)



Canada is a net importer of \$5 billion in U.S. auto products.





The U.S. purchases 50-80% of its needed critical minerals of zinc, nickel, tellerium, and vanadium from Canada.

U.S. will import over \$100 billion in oil and gas in 2024.





Canadian tourism to the U.S. gives the U.S. a surplus of \$15 billion in total services trade.
